AREA 63 FALL CONFERENCE MINUTES: OCT 06, 2007

Meeting opened by Area Chair, Perry G. How it works, 12 Traditions and 12 Concepts were read by Sarah, Marlin and Dominic respectively.

DELEGATES REPORT: Estelle G, Panel 56. (Attached below on page 4)

AREA 63 (SD) DISTRICT REPORTS

DIST 1: Dwight C, Alt DCM; located in NW SD including Bison, Lemmon, Cheyenne Eagle Butte and Faith. They have 4 groups, all active meetings and 3 votes at conference. All communities are active w/ members but Lemmon is down to 3 members. No news from Cheyenne Eagle Butte. Issues facing the district are the lack of members and distance between the groups. They just learned Cheyenne EB is in their district and plan to make contact w/ them.

DIST 2: Anne F, DCM; located in western SD, including Rapid City, east to Wall. There are 28 registered groups, with 12 active in district meetings and nine votes. Phillip group had an anniversary meeting. The district is working to address issues raised in our inventory and encouraging participation in upcoming district officer and GSR elections.

DIST 3: Jodi J, DCM; located in west-central SD including White River, Martin, Kyle, St Francis, Mission and several others not reporting. There are 5 registered groups and 2 votes. The district is becoming more active and they are sharing ideas on contributions, workshops, remote communities and growth within the district. Jodi J took a photo that was accepted and has been printed in the 2008 Grapevine calendar.

DIST 4: Bob G, DCM; located in southeastern SD, including Yankton, Vermillion, Freeman, Tabor, Tyndall and Springfield. They have 9 registered groups, 4 active at district level and 3 votes at conference. Attendance at meetings is a problem still. Dist 4 suggests that groups attending the Gateway treatment center should bring their group or district meeting list.

DIST 5: Joan G, DCM; located in East Central SD, including Sioux Falls, Chester, Madison, Brandon, Salem and Flandreau. 23 registered groups, 13 active at district level and 8 votes present at conference. The dist is working on writing guidelines. Dist 5 is active in carrying the message to jails, treatment centers and the VA. Elections are being held in Nov. The district plans to submit bid for 2009 Spring Conference. There is a new group, Austin Recovery Group. Dist 5 is still expecting a Spanish speaking meeting to start in Sioux Falls.

DIST 6: Jess C, DCM; located in NE SD, including Aberdeen, Redfield, Webster, Milbank, Big Stone, Britton. 10 registered groups, 6 active at district w/ 4 votes. Dist 6 is hosting '08 Spring Conference. PLEASE PRE-REGISTER!

DIST 7: Rod B, DCM; located in N Central SD, including Mobridge, Herries, Selby, Hoven, Gettysburg, Pierre, Ft Thompson, Murdo, Draper and Vivian. 12 registered groups with 7 active at dist level and 3 votes. Quiet summer but had some fellowship activities. Still lacking support at local prison & wanting better participation w/i the district.

DIST 8: Mark S, newly elected DCM: located in E Central SD. DeSmet, Huron, Miller, Mitchell, Parkston, Wessington Springs and Woonsocket. There are approx 10 registered and active groups in the district.

DIST 9: Leslie D, DCM: Located in Brookings, Clear Lake & Watertown with 10 registered groups, 11 active at the district level. They had 6 votes at the assembly. Elections for 2008 occurred in September, with all positions being filled.

DIST 10: Brian C, DCM: Located in the southern Black Hills, including Hot Springs, Custer and Hill City. There are approx 5 registered groups, but none are active at dist level. Lack of participation is the sole issue facing the district.

DIST 11: No report provided. The district is located in southeast region, including Beresford, Centerville, Canton, Parker, Irene, Alcester, Elk Point and surrounding towns. Dist 11 is currently not holding district meetings.

DIST 13: Karla M, DCM reported they are located in N Hills, including Belle Fourche, Buffalo, Deadwood, Lead, Spearfish, Sturgis & Whitewood. They have 8 registered groups with 8 active in the district, with 7 votes. Thanks to Bob M and his committee for hosting a great 2008 Fall Conference.

Election Notes: A discussion and vote was held in the middle of the election process regarding the difference between a simple majority and, what turns out to be, plurality, both of which are mentioned in the service manual. The Area was electing the committee chairs by way of selecting the person who simply had "the most votes". Yet, the discussion prior to the election was that chairs would be selected by a simple majority. Majority was looked up on the Wikipedia web site. Interestingly enough, the definition was as follows: "a majority, also known as a simple majority is a group that is more than half of the entire group. This should not be confused with a plurality, which is a subset having the largest number of parts. A plurality is not necessarily a majority, as the largest subset may be less than half of the entire group.
