

AREA 63 SUMMER WORKSHOP AUGUST 25, 2007

Meeting opened at 9:10am by Area Chair, Perry G. How it works, 12 Traditions and 12 Concepts were read by Alyce E., Jess C. and Eric C., respectively. New GSRs & DCMs were welcomed and assigned a "partner" for the day.

DELEGATES REPORT: Estelle G, Panel 56. (Attached below page 5)

AREA 63 (SD) DISTRICT REPORTS

DIST 1: Sam, DCM; located in northwestern SD, including Bison, Lemmon, Faith. DCM has visited (3) groups in the district. Also, thank you to the individual(s) that donated books and literature to Dist 1. This donation allows access to dist members to the entire suite of literature offered by AA.

DIST 2: Anne F, DCM; located in western SD, including Rapid City, east to Wall. There are 29 registered groups, with 15 active in district meetings. Dist heard a delegates report; they also held an inventory in Aug. One result of that inventory is that the dist now reads one concept at each district meeting. Thank you to those who participated and assisted w/ the inventory.

DIST 3: Jodi, reported for Lloyd S, DCM; located in west-central SD, including Mission, Whiter River, St Francis and Martin have meetings. No news from Parmalee, Pine Ridge and Kyle. Dist 3 meets two times per year.

DIST 4: Bob G, DCM; located in southeastern SD, including Yankton, Vermillion, Freeman, Tabor, Tyndall and Springfield. They have 9 registered groups, 4 active at district level and 2 votes at conference. All groups are holding meetings and active, but few participate in district meetings. This continues to be a problem.

DIST 5: Kris, reported for Joan G, DCM; located in East Central SD, including Sioux Falls, Chester, Madison, Brandon, Salem and Flandreau. 21 registered groups, 13 active at district level and 6 votes present at conference. Dist 5 is alive and well. Carrying the message at county jail and treatment centers; continuing to develop dist guidelines, which is generating unity within the dist. Dist 5 was pleased with the results of the Spring Conference; Dist 5 will submit bid to host 2009 Spring Conference. Dist is still planning to welcome a Spanish speaking group.

DIST 6: Jess C, DCM; located in NE SD, including Aberdeen, Redfield, Webster, Milbank, Big Stone, Britton with 10 registered groups, 4 active at district w/ 3 votes. Dist 6 is hosting 2008 Spring Conference and attendance at dist meetings has increased due to planning this activity.

DIST 7: Rod B, DCM; located in N Central SD, including Mobridge, Herries, Selfby, Hoven, Gettysburg, Pierre, Ft Thompson, Murdo, Draper and Vivian. 12 registered groups with 7 active at dist level and 2 votes present.

DIST 8: Mark S, DCM: located in E Central SD. DeSmet, Huron, Miller, Mitchell, Parkston, Wessington Springs and Woonsocket. There are approx 8 registered groups. Huron is strong. Miller is doing well. Birthday night draws approx 35 people; Mitchell group doing well.

DIST 9: Leslie D, DCM: Located in Brookings, Clear Lake & Watertown with 10 registered groups, 11 active at the district level. They had 4 votes at the assembly. Dist 9 is considering installing a phone line where people can call and talk to a member. Dist held a forum to discuss the service positions per the pending election in September.

DIST 10: No Report. Located in the southern Black Hills, including Hot Springs, Custer and Hill City.

DIST 11: No Report. Located in southeast region, including Beresford, Centerville, Canton, Parker, Irene, Alcester, Elk Point and surrounding towns.

DIST 13: Karla M, DCM; located in Northern Hills, including Belle Fourche, Buffalo, Deadwood, Lead, Spearfish, Sturgis & Whitewood. They have 9 registered groups with 7 active in the district and 6 votes today. All meetings are doing well. Hosting the 2007 Fall Conference Oct 5-7 at Spearfish Holiday Inn. Estelle gave her delegates report.

DIST 12, 14 & 15 are not active at the Area 63 level.

7. Considered whether or not to increase the 2008 budget.

POLICY AGENDA: Norm chaired but no business was discussed.

2. Discussed the "GSR School" that will be presented tonight.
3. Reviewed budget and recommend \$50 reduction in the budget.

2. Reviewed the job description for literature chair.
3. Reviewed the budget.

4. Considered lowering the budget for 2008.
5. Considered selling archival CDs through the Grapevine.
6. Considered adding duties to the literature job description.

REMOTE COMMUNITIES / SPECIAL NEEDS COMMITTEE: Jim K chaired with 6 members in attendance.

1. Reviewed the Special Needs Assignment Update dated 6/13/07. Gayle R is GSO liaison for special needs. She will rotate out and Valerie O will be in that position from 2008-09.
2. Reviewed the literature catalog and the cassettes we have on hand.
3. Committee is drafting a letter to DCMs to inform them of our resources and requesting info from them about needs in their districts.
4. Discussed the 2008 budget and suggest lowering 2008 budget by \$200.

ARCHIVES: Darla J chaired with 7 members in attendance.

1. Discussed dates to visit Toben Transfer and go through the archives inventory.
2. Plan to order 12 archive workbooks.
3. Discussed need to relocate the archives from Toben Transfer in Mitchell to a site that is climate controlled.
4. Discussed budget for 2008.
5. Discussed how they could host a workshop on archives.
6. Consider keeping continuity in archives.
7. Consider suspending the "traveling archives" due to the fragile condition of the items.

REPORT & CHARTER: Chris D chaired with 4 members in attendance.

1. Reviewed the minutes and budget for 2007, year to date. We are on target to meet the budget.
2. Discussed Area 63 proposal for an inventory. Worked out questions on survey and time for inventory at the upcoming 2008 Spring Conference.
3. Discussed planned time for inventory at the upcoming 2008 Spring Conference. Worked w/ Perry G, current chairperson and Estelle G, delegate.
4. Recommend Area 63 take a survey/inventory and discuss the results at the 2008 Spring Conference.

CORRECTIONS: Dean B chaired with 10 members in attendance.

1. Discussed setting up speakers for the conferences.
2. Discussed temporary sponsorship forms for inmates.
3. Discussed budget for 2008 and recommend increasing to \$750 from \$600.
4. Consider contacting female group members near Pierre to get more qualified members for prison meetings.

FINANCE: John T chaired with 6 members in attendance.

1. Reviewed the treasurer's report.
2. Reviewed draft letter to fellowship from treasurer.
3. Audited check books.
4. Considered proposed 2008 budget.
5. Recommend approval of 2008 budget to be presented to the Area and voted on at Fall Conference.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. This item will be voted on at the Fall Conference, October 5-7, 2007.

A motion was made and 2nd and approved that Area 63 will conduct an inventory, a survey of the groups and districts, the results of which will be discussed at the 2008 Spring Conference in Aberdeen, May 16-18, 2008. The motion passed without desenting votes.

Does your group or district wish to conduct an inventory of the Area and to discuss the results of that inventory at the 2008 Spring Conference.

Background: Questions asked focused on the survey and the timing of the inventory at Spring Conference. The survey was created from a compilation of a concepts survey from the general service office. The groups and districts will be asked to discuss the inventory, compile their answers and voice their group/districts opinion at the 2008 Spring Conference. The inventory will be reviewed at the conference, Saturday, intermixed between the business meeting, allowing approx 3.5-hours to discussion. The groups and districts will be asked to bring written responses to the survey so that we can compile the responses in a booklet form so the Area can review now and in the future.

2. This item will be voted on at the Fall Conference, October 5-7, 2007.

A motion was made & 2nd to present the 2008 proposed budget to be voted on at the 63 Fall Conference in Spearfish, SD. No discussion was heard and the motion was passed by a unanimous majority.

Does your group or district approve the proposed 2008 budget found on page 8?

3. A motion was made & 2nd for Dist 5 to host the 2009 Spring Conference, contingent on the area chairperson and finance chair to co-sign the contract for the facilities. Discussion ensued including a voice from Dist 5 that clarified that the motion to host was made with a contingency clause stating that Dist 5 would host the conference only if all contracts required to be signed for this conference were co-signed by the Area Treasure and Chairperson. Dist 5 reserved the right to withdraw their bid if the Area officers did not co-sign the contracts. This caused a rather long discussion with several voices heard. One voice said that the area ultimately pays for the conference, regardless of who signs the contract "locally", so a contingency clause is not necessary. Another voice indicated that this contingency clause takes the conference away from the local district and makes the Area an authority, dictating to the host district what they are to do and not do. Another voice mentioned that the adoption of this amendment, with the contingency stated, would be creating new policy for Area 63 and should be taken through a committee system. There were collective voices agreeing that caution should be taken not to be afraid to host an Area Conference and that the contingency was only a formality and encouraged passage without fear of the co-signature clause. A reference to the past minutes, Summer 2006 Assembly, was read. The motion was withdrawn by a member from dist 5 and will be taken back to district for further consideration.

DELEGATE'S REPORT: Estelle G. - Area 63 Panel 56

Welcome to the Summer Workshop! (or as I like to say "FUN-shop). A special welcome if this is your first Area Assembly, we are so glad to have you here. I would like highlight some things that are going on in our "AA World."

What's happening in our Area: I had the privilege of giving my Delegates report in Rapid City in July to Districts 2 and 13. Thank-you to Anne F. for organizing the event. There was a good attendance and discuss of items going on at our General Service Office as well as right here at home. I have the updated group contribution forms. The Spring Conference will be held May 16, 17, & 18th in beautiful downtown Aberdeen. Have you seen the new look of our Area Website? Wow! Great job to John E. and his committee. What's happening in our Region: We are part of the West Central Region. This includes Minnesota, Iowa, North Dakota, Nebraska, Wyoming, Montana and of course Area 63 South Dakota.
