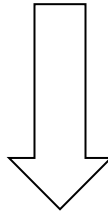


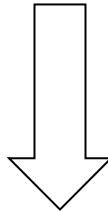
FLOW CHART OF AN AREA 63 AGENDA ITEM

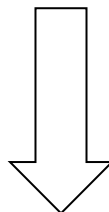
An idea, suggestion, question, concern, or subject comes from AA members, GSR's, DCM's Area Committee Members or Delegates- Agenda items appropriate for the Area level may concern any aspect of the Area Conferences and Assemblies including schedules and minutes, Area Committee work (Archives, Corrections/Treatment, Cooperation with the Professional Community, Finance, Literature/Grapevine, Public Information and Area Web, and Remote Communities.)



And is first shared or discussed at the group or district level, and then is sent to



the Area 63 Policy/Admissions/Agenda Committee who will assign the item to an Area Committee for review and possible action as a
RECOMMENDATION or REPORT



If an item comes to the Assembly floor as a Recommendation then ACTION by the Assembly is required

If the item comes to the Assembly floor as a Report then NO ACTION by the Assembly is required.

****On many of the Conference Agenda Items only a "Sense of the Assembly" is needed.
